ATTENDANCE:

LATE WORK POLICY:

MAKE-UP/EXTRA CREDIT WORK POLICY:

<u>No make-up work or extra credit</u> will be accepted. The goal is to ensure students do their best work the first time around and understand their effort is linked to their grade.

HOMEWORK:

Student homework will be sent home <u>Monday through Friday</u>. <u>IT IS EXPECTED TO BE</u> <u>RETURNED THE FOLLOWING DAY</u>. If homework is missed due to an absence, it must be turned in two days after the date of return along with any other missed work. If homework requires a parent or guardian signature, no credit will be given if there is no signature. If students are going on vacation, students must give two weeks' notice and work must be handed in the day they return.

GRADING:

Grades will be determined by classroom assignments, homework assignments, and assessments. Grades will be calculated using the district standard. You will need your student's number and birthday to set-up your account.

A proficiency scale has been developed for each essential standard in all subjects. Each scale consists of the following levels: **below (1)**, **approaching (2)**, **proficient (3)**, **and above proficient (4)**. Each student will be assessed on the continuum according to their mastery at that time. Every student is expected to meet the secure level requirements. The exceeds level is available to students for each skill to challenge their learning.
